Primary skin irritation testing has been performed in accordance with the guidelines of the International Organization for Standardization Part 10: Tests for Irritation and Sensitization. The test consisted of determining the potential for a topical application of the test article to irritate skin of a rabbit. The rabbit is specified as an appropriate animal model for evaluating potential skin irritants by the current ANSI/AAMI/ISO standards. The rabbit is widely used for this purpose and relative ranking of irritant scores can be determined. The Primary Irritation Index of the test article was calculated to be 0.0 (no erythema, no edema). No irritation was observed on the skin of the rabbits. Berkshire is confident that this test result can be a reasonable voucher to show the harmlessness of the mask for skin irritation. The material contains no chemicals or binders.
